

Report of the CSTM Membership Secretary, 2001

Figures in this report are as of 2001 October 9. Members who have not paid up beyond the end of 2000 have now been deleted. As we will be publishing three single Bulletins in 2001, current individual memberships have been extended by one issue. See Table 1.

Since the last report (October 2000) there have been 16 new individual memberships added. With deletions, there has been a net change of minus 6. See Table 2. There were also 5 new institutional memberships added, for a net change of minus 1. See Table 3. The overall net change is minus 7.

While this is still a drop in membership, it is much lower than the minus 25 of last year.

This report also contains a summary of members with their post-secondary affiliation. See Table 4.

The long term membership trend is shown in Table 5 and the associated graph.

The figures in this report are approximately comparable to last year's figures.
