

Report of the CSTM Membership Secretary, 2003

Figures in this report are as of 2003 October 19. Members who have not paid up beyond the end of 2002 have now been deleted. See Table 1.

Since the last report (October 2002) there have been 32 new individual memberships added. With deletions, there has been a net change of plus 8. See Table 2. There was also 1 new institutional membership added, for a net change of minus 4. See Table 3. The overall net change is plus 4.

This is the first increase in membership since 1994, though I would be hesitant to read too much into that. The overall trend remains downward.

This report also contains a summary of members with their post-secondary affiliation. See Table 4.

The long term membership trend is shown in Table 5 and the associated graph. The decline is about 4% per annum compounded.

The figures in this report are approximately comparable to last year's figures.
