

Report of the CSTM Membership Secretary, 2008

Figures in this report are as of 2008 November 10. Members who have not paid up beyond the third quarter of 2007 have now been deleted. See Table 1.

Since the last report (September 2007) there have been 21 new individual memberships added. With deletions, there has been a net change of minus 22. See Table 2. There was 1 new institutional memberships added which, with deletions, gives a net change of minus 4. See Table 3. The overall net change is minus 26.

This year continues the downward trend in membership of last year, and indeed of the last 20 years.
